

National Team Manager Role Description

The SKA are seeking to appoint a National team manager, who will act as a link between the national team & coach and the SKA as well as supporting the national coach.

Key tasks and responsibilities:

- Support the national coach in the organisation of a training programme for the national team.
- Communicate with the national team on behalf of the SKA and the national coach.
- Keep the SKA informed of all issues relating to the national team.
- Attend domestic and international tournaments and support the team in their preparation for these tournaments.
- Support the team in organising fundraising events.
- Act as an ambassador for the Scottish Korfball Association, and conduct yourself in a manner consistent with that position.

Oversight

The National team manager is appointed by the SKA Management Committee, and ultimately is responsible to that group as a whole.

The SKA will also delegate some of its authority to an Internationals Sub-committee under the Terms of Reference. The National Team Manager shall be invited to contribute, on a non-voting basis, to this Sub-Committee's decisions except where there is a direct conflict of interest, when the team manager will be asked to withdraw. Attendance at sub-committee meetings may be by phone, Skype, or similar.

Expenses

The role is voluntary, however the SKA will cover travel expenses within Scotland that have been incurred by the National Team Manager in the course of their duties providing proper evidence is submitted, and subject to a maximum cap agreed in advance.

The SKA will endeavour to cover some of the costs of attendance at competitions, but the appointed candidate must recognise that due to the SKA's limited budget, that person will be required to bear most costs.

Person specification

Essential

- Excellent communicator.
- A thorough knowledge and understanding of the structure, potential and challenges of the Scottish korfball system.
- A full understanding of the responsibilities of the role.
- Demonstrable communication and leadership skills.
- Fluency in English.

- Availability to travel to IKF international tournaments and other national team training weekends.

Desirable:

- Experience of playing or coaching at international (club) level.
