

Rule	Exemption
1.2 - Field of Play	Pitch sizes smaller than 40x20m are permitted.
3.3 - Shot clock	Shot clocks will not be used in 2020/21 SKL competition.
4.6 - Referee	Assistants are permitted at the referees request, to assist in score and time keeping.
4.7 - Assistant referee	Assistant referees are not permitted in 2020/21 SKL competition.
4.8 - Jury	A jury is not required in 2020/21 SKL competition.
4.9 - Timekeeper	see 4.6 (match is still ended by the referee's whistle).
4.11 - Scorekeeper	see 4.6 & 4.9.
5.2 - Playing time	Real playing time will not be used in 2020/21 SKL competition.
5.5 - Goals	Matches may end in a draw in 2020/21 SKL competition.
5.8 - Time out	One time out per team per match. Requests can be made directly from coach to referee.
5.9 - Substitutions of players	A coach may communicate directly to the referee to request a substitution.
6.9 - To passive play	All amendments for passive play in non-real playing time are adopted: throwing the ball far outside the field; kicking the ball when the game has been stopped; time wasted when changing zones; time wasted during the preparation of a throw off; time wasting during substitution.
6.17 - To shoot when one plays without a personal opponent	This rule will not be adopted at any level of 2020/21 SKL competition. A non-shooter must still be nominated and the following rules apply: If a player who is playing without a personal opponent throws the ball and it hits the korf, then this shall be considered to be a shot and is penalised under this rule. If the coach of the attacking side fails to inform the referee, then the referee must see to it that they does so at once.
7.6 - Disciplinary	Referee's jurisdiction will begin at the start of the hour time slot allocated to their match, and will end when the following match in a triple fixture begins, or if it is the final fixture, when the match forms have been signed.
