

Scotland National Team Assistant Coach

The SKA are looking to appoint a National Team Assistant Coach.

Role Background

The Scottish Korfball Association is seeking to appoint, on a voluntary basis, a National Team Assistant Coach for the upcoming training and tournament cycle. We are seeking a candidate for the European Championships 2021 and beyond. This is a voluntary role, although the SKA will meet reasonable expenses including tournament travel and accommodation when required.

Role Description

The primary role of the Assistant Coach is to support the Head Coach of the National Team, and includes coaching at all training sessions and international tournaments.

This includes:

- Leading a trial weekend in Scotland (21st and 22nd of August)
- Leading specific drills within training sessions
- Supporting the selection of a team for tournaments and International competitions
- Supporting the delivery of high quality training weekends in the lead up to International competitions
- Liaising with the Head Coach, Team Manager and SKA Management Committee on organisational duties
- Leading the Scottish national team in International competitions
- Adhere to the policies and procedures of Scotland Korfball

We are looking for someone who has:

- Experience of coaching korfball at a high level (minimum of Scottish Korfball League Division 1 or equivalent (e.g. Regional League in England))
- A thorough knowledge and understanding of the structure, potential and challenges of the Scottish korfball system, or willingness to gain such knowledge
- A full understanding of the responsibilities of the role
- Demonstrable communication and leadership skills.
- Availability to travel to IKF international tournaments and other tournaments identified for development through agreement
- Willingness to travel through to Edinburgh on a regular basis for National Team training.

All candidates will be considered for the position regardless of previous experience.

The Assistant Coach is appointed by the SKA Management Committee and whilst they will work under the Head Coach, they will ultimately be responsible to the SKA Management Committee.
